was there.



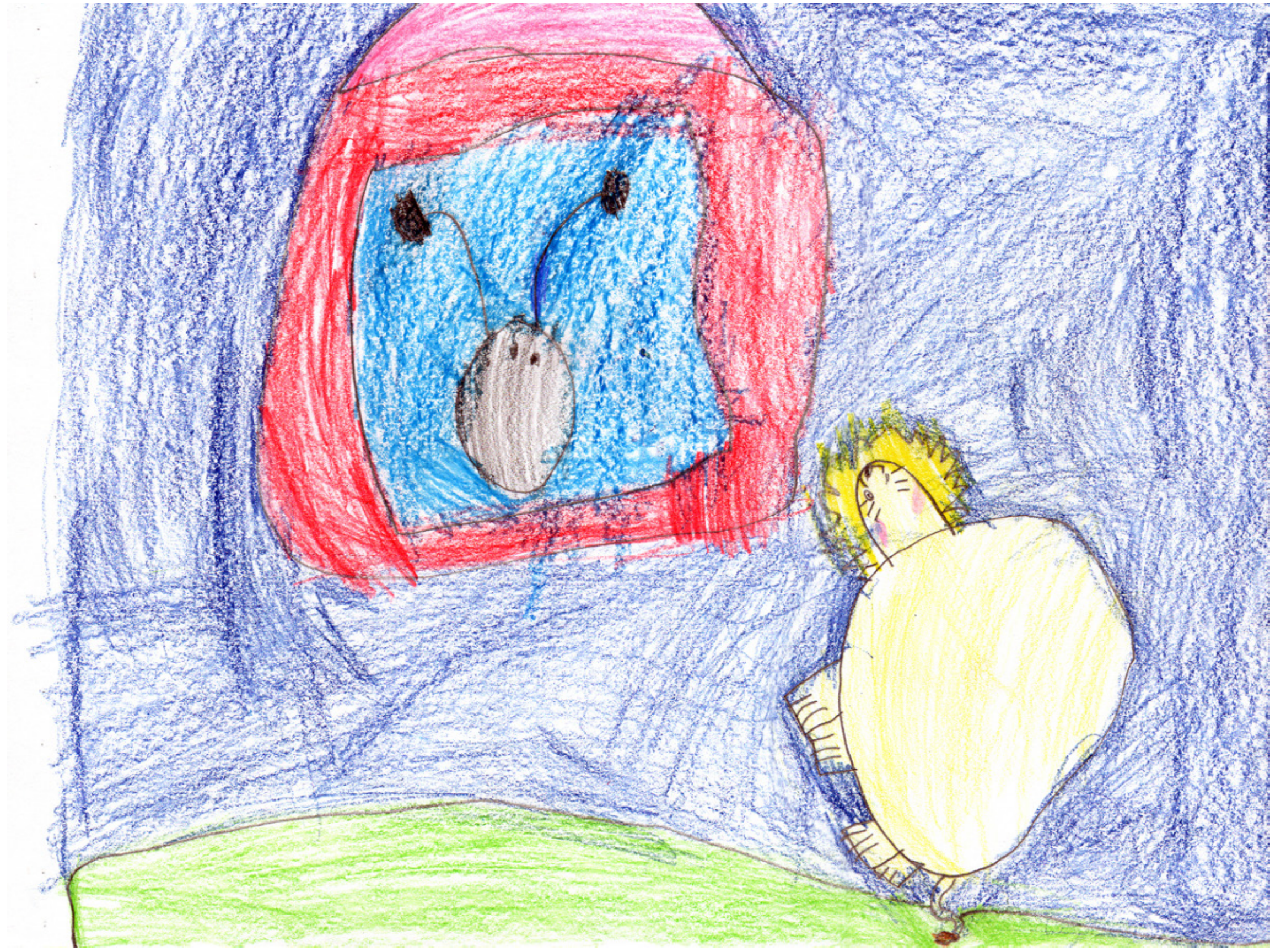
